Networking and lunch begins at 11 am. The membership meeting and training begins at 12 noon.

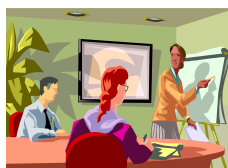
Please join us for this valuable networking and educational opportunity.
