Corporal Williams started his law enforcement career

Williams has received additional training in illegal drug sales and use as well as computer-related crimes, internet-related crimes, and computer forensics. During the year that he served as a detective, Garrett investigated most of the crimes on campus that involved computers or the internet, which resulted in felony arrests that helped solve other open crime cases.
